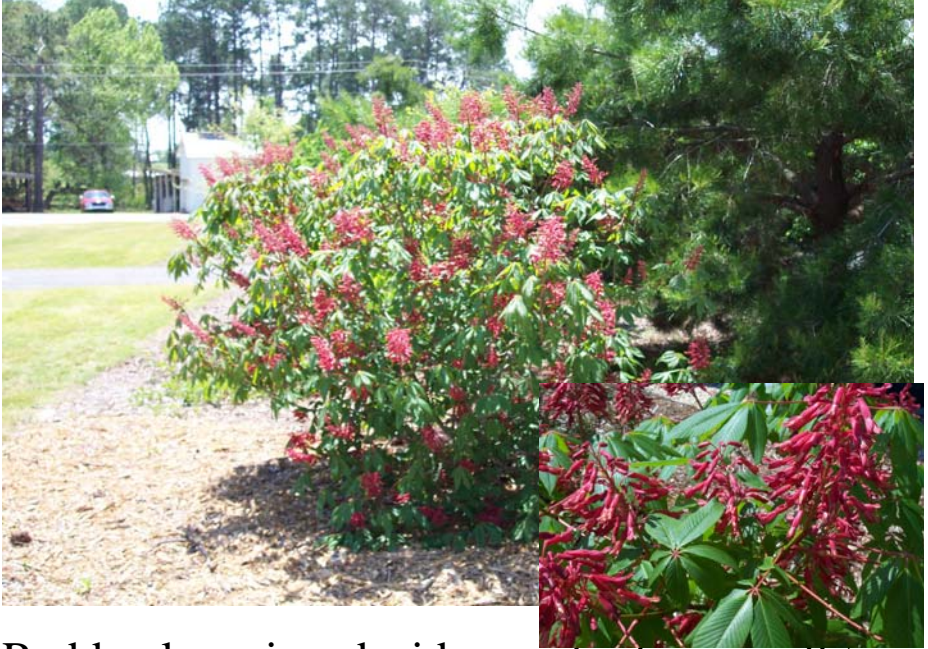


Aesculus pavia

Red Buckeye



Red buckeye is a deciduous shrub or small tree with showy spikes of red flowers which occur at the tips of stems, in early spring. Also noteworthy are the light brown capsules which split open to reveal one to three shiny brown seeds. The bright red flowers are eye-catching as an accent plant or in a shrub border. Red buckeye is also useful as food for wildlife: flowers for hummingbirds and bees, nuts for squirrels.

Height: 10' - 20', Spread: 10' - 20'
