

Amorpha fruticosa

False Indigo



This deciduous, native, multi-stemmed shrub is attractive to butterflies as a nectar source and larval food. It does well in most soils, from occasionally wet to dry. The flowers have a subtle color, blue-purple with orange-yellow anthers, but are showy during the summer. Flowers are produced on new growth. Plant in full sun.

Height: 6' – 20'. Spread: 5' – 15'
