Trumpetvine



Trumpetvine has vibrant orange flowers which attract birds, particularly hummingbirds, and butterflies during a long flowering season. *Campsis* is a good cover for arbors and fences, and can be used in woodland settings or as a specimen plant. Prune to train and control the shape. Trumpetvine does not twine and choke plants to which it attaches (unlike the invasive wisteria and honeysuckle). *Campsis* tolerates part shade, but does best in full sun. It does well in most soil types, from occasionally wet to dry.

Height: 10' – 50' Spread: 20' – 80'
