

# *Eupatorium fistulosum*

## Joe Pye Weed



**Joe Pye Weed is a perennial, native to eastern regions of the United States. Covered with clusters of pinkish-purple flowers summer into fall, it is a source of nectar for many insects, especially Swallowtail butterflies. Can be used as background plant due to height, adds color and structure. Prune in late spring for more flowers, at a shorter height. Grows in well-drained soil, of differing types, and naturalizes well. *E. fistulosum* is slightly drought tolerant, but will grow best in moist sites. It will grow in partial shade but flowers more profusely, with less height, in full sun.**

**Height: 4' – 10' Spread: 4' – 8'**
