

Hydrangea quercifolia

Oakleaf Hydrangea



A deciduous shrub with panicles of white flowers in summer, lobed leaves, and rich brown inner bark that is exposed with maturity. As the flowers age the color changes from white to pink, then brown; can be used in fresh or dried floral arrangements. Slow to medium growth rate, and well worth the wait. Grows in dry or moist soil, prefers light shade.

Height: 4' – 8'. Spread: 4' – 8'
