Southern Blue Flag



Southern Blue Flag has typical Iris structure. Native to wet areas in the southern regions of the United States, the tall, medium green foliage and blue-purple flowers in summer make an elegant show in the home landscape. Most at home in bogs or water gardens, it can be grown in average garden soils, with a supply of consistent moisture. Grows in well-drained soil, of differing types, and naturalizes well. The foliage is darker in partial shade, but the flowers are more profuse in full sun.

Height: 2' – 4' Spread: 1' – 2'
